CLERKSHIP APPLICATIONS

Positions: Judge Woods is considering applications from prospective law clerks for positions beginning in Fall 2024. Applicants for Fall 2024 positions are encouraged to submit their applications as soon as possible.

Applications: Judge Woods is participating in the pilot Law Clerk Hiring Plan and, accordingly, will not consider applications from students graduating in 2025 until June 10, 2024. Applicants graduating in 2024 or earlier may apply at any time.

Application Process: Applicants should apply through OSCAR. Applications should contain a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, undergraduate transcript, a writing sample, and three letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation may be submitted under separate cover.

Applicants should not submit paper applications or applications via email, unless they do not have access to OSCAR. In that case, applications may be submitted via email. Clerkship applicants should visit Judge Woods' profile on OSCAR for updated information regarding vacancies and other hiring information. **Applicants should not call Chambers.**

INTERNSHIP AND EXTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS

Positions: Judge Woods is currently accepting part-time and full-time internship applications for Spring 2024 on a rolling basis until all positions are filled.

Beginning on December 1, 2023, Judge Woods will be accepting full-time internship applications for Summer 2024 on a rolling basis until all positions are filled.

Beginning on April 1, 2024, Judge Woods will be accepting part-time and full-time internship applications for Fall 2024 on a rolling basis until all positions are filled.

Applications: Applications should be e-mailed to the address above with "Internship/Externship Application: Fall 2024" (or appropriate term) in the subject line, and should contain a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, and one writing sample, all in PDF format. Applicants may update their application with new information as it becomes available.
