Law Clerk Hiring Information Louis L. Stanton, United States District Judge

Judge Stanton hires one clerk per year for a two-year clerkship to commence in September.

Judge Stanton is a senior judge who does not normally take criminal cases, so his calendar tends to concentrate on matters on which he specialized as a lawyer, i.e. commercial and antitrust matters.

As he places considerable emphasis on grades and class rank, applications should include at least two years of grades. Judge Stanton values Law Review or similar experience. Letters of recommendation are carefully considered and may be submitted separately or with the application.

Judge Stanton does not participate in OSCAR and applications should be submitted by mail to chambers. He generally hires in the fall for the following September.
