

ALVIN K. HELLERSTEIN, U.S.D.J.:

This master calendar collects claims of property damage arising from the terrorist-related aircraft crashes into the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001. There are two sets of claims pending before me, those relating to the destruction of the offices of Cantor Fitzgerald & Co. in the North Tower (Tower One) of the World Trade Center (“the Cantor claims”),¹ and those relating to the destruction of Towers One, Two, Three, Four, and Seven, of the World Trade Center and the effect of their destruction on long-term leases to those Towers held by companies affiliated with Larry Silverstein (“the Silverstein claims”).² All other property-related claims have been dismissed after settlements or after resolution, subject to various pending appeals.

Counsel in the Cantor and Silverstein claims shall appear for status conferences with me, in Courtroom 14D, on December 17, 2012, at 4:00 p.m. for the Cantor claims, and at 4:15 p.m. for the Silverstein claims. As for the Cantor claims, I propose to discuss,

1. Whether any discovery remains after the stipulated enlarged date for taking depositions of experts, April 15, 2013;
2. Procedures to shape and define the issues to be tried, and the length of the trial; and
3. The date when trial shall begin.

As for the Silverstein claims, I propose to discuss:

1. Whether any discovery is pending or remains to be taken;
2. Whether a trial should be conducted on the correspondence of insurance recoveries and potential tort recoveries, as discussed in my recent opinions³
3. Whether any consequent trial should be consolidated with the trial of the Cantor claims and, if so, the proceedings of such a trial.

Counsel in all other cases are invited to attend and, to the extent appropriate, to participate.
