

ORDER SCHEDULING DAMAGES TRIAL AND PRETRIAL PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS the case previously scheduled to begin trial of damages on September 24, 2007, Driscoll v. Argenbright Security, No. 02 Civ. 7912 (AKH), has settled; and

WHEREAS thirteen wrongful death cases arising out of the terrorist hijackings of September 11, 2001 remain pending against the aviation defendants in the 21 MC 97 docket; and

WHEREAS separate trials of damages and liability remain “conducive to expedition and economy,” Fed. R. Civ. P. 42(b); In re September 11 Litig., No. 21 MC 97, 2007 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 48864 (S.D.N.Y. Jul. 5, 2007); it is hereby

ORDERED that Ambrose v. American Airlines, No. 02 Civ. 7150 (AKH) be made ready for a trial of damages only, to begin November 5, 2007; and it is further

ORDERED that the parties appear for a pretrial conference on November 1, 2007 at 2:00p.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that the parties shall agree to a schedule governing exchanges of pretrial and trial information, pretrial briefs, requests for voir dire, requests to charge, etc., culminating in the necessary filings with the Court by October 26, 2007.
