The following order partially modifying certain language set forth in Order 24A, (13-MD-2434, Doc. 2401; 13-MC-2434, Doc. 114), is hereby adopted:


1. Order 24A currently states in several scenarios (¶¶ 4-13) that the parties shall identify candidate replacement or removal cases for the Second Disposition Pool (“SDP”) “within fourteen days of the dismissal order.” (13-MD-2434, Doc. 2401; 13-MC-2434, Doc. 114.)

2. Effective from the date of this Order, if a SDP case is voluntarily dismissed by Plaintiffs pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i), which does not require approval by this Court, the relevant party shall identify a replacement or removal case or cases within fourteen days of when the voluntary dismissal was filed via ECF.

All other instructions and deadlines set forth in Order 24A, (13-MD-2434, Doc. 2401; 13-MC-2434, Doc. 114), remain in effect.
