ALVIN K. HELLERSTEIN, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

On April 21, 2004, I ordered cases dismissed with claims pending before the Victim Compensation Fund (VCF). I further provided that any plaintiff in those cases who is aggrieved by the dismissal and who is found ineligible to claim to the VCF may move by May 24, 2004 to have his action restored.

The law firm of Barasch McGarry Salzman Penson & Lim (Barasch McGarry) now bring an Order to Show Cause before this court to permit them to withdraw as counsel for plaintiffs Peter Acquafredda, William Carroll, Donald Casey, James Mullins, Joseph Skonieczny, James Stang, Doris Martinez and Michelle Paolini.

It is hereby Ordered that Barasch McGarry shall personally serve each of the above-named plaintiffs by May 27, 2004, except where the person is not present and cannot be served personally, in which case counsel shall serve in the next most expeditious method as provided by Fed. R. Civ. P. 4 and N.Y. C.P.L.R., but no later than June 2, 2004. Plaintiffs shall then have until June 11, 2004 at 12:00 p.m. to show cause as to why counsel should not be permitted to withdraw and why the May 24, 2004 date should not bar each of them from requesting restoration of their cases to the court's calendar.
