ALVIN K. HELLERSTEIN, U.S.D.J.:

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2003, this Court issued an Order requiring that any plaintiffs, whose late notice of claim applications have been denied by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey and who elect to pursue their applications, file motions seeking leave to serve a late notice of claim by January 21, 2003;

WHEREAS, the Court has received such motions from a number of plaintiffs;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT,

1. Opposition to all motions for leave to serve a late notice of claim shall be served on or before February 26, 2003, and reply papers shall be served on or before March 12, 2003.
2. Magistrate Judge Theodore H. Katz will hear the motions for leave to serve a late notice of claim, in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), at a date to be determined. Courtesy copies of all papers shall be sent to Magistrate Judge Katz.
3. The Port Authority will provide notice of this order to all counsel and pro se plaintiffs that have served a motion for leave to serve a late notice of claim.
