Law Clerks

<u>Positions</u>: Judge Broderick posts all available term and volunteer law clerk positions on OSCAR.

<u>Application Process</u>: Applications are only accepted through OSCAR and are reviewed on a rolling basis. No Applicant should send their application by email or by mail to chambers. The application materials required for each position and any other information relevant to the application process will be listed on OSCAR as part of the vacancy information for the relevant position. Prospective applicants should not call or email chambers to request additional information on applying for positions or on pending applications. The only exception is that applicants who are unable to use or access OSCAR or whose recommenders are unable to use the OSCAR may call chambers at 212-805-6165 to request an alternative submission mechanism.

<u>Application Timing</u>: Judge Broderick is adhering to the new Law Clerk Hiring Plan (<u>https://oscar.uscourts.gov/federal_law_clerk_hiring_pilot</u>). Rising third-year law students may apply according to the Plan timeline. Law school graduates or current third-year law students may submit applications at any time. Applicants who are not able to submit all of their grades as part of their application should supplement their applications as additional grades are released.
