Petitions for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 Immigration Custody and Requests for Emergency Relief

This notice clarifies procedures for filing a Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 when challenging the legality of immigration custody and addresses related requests for emergency relief.

Filing Event

When filing an application for a Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, use the ECF Filing Civil Events → Initial Pleadings and Service → Complaints and Other Initiating Documents → Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and follow the prompts.

Nature of Suit

File a <u>Civil Cover Sheet</u> (**new** in 12/25) and, if applicable, select nature of suit 463 (Alien Detainee). The nature of suit selection on the Civil Cover Sheet must match that entered on the CM/ECF screen.

Emergency Relief

Emergency applications, such as those seeking immediate release from detention, should be filed <u>separately</u> from any case initiating document using the following applicable <u>ECF Filing Events</u> (Motions):

- Motion to Show Cause,
- Proposed Order to Show Cause with Emergency Relief,
- Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, or
- Proposed Temporary Restraining Order.

When filing an emergency application, you must take the <u>additional step</u> of alerting the court to the pending application.

In New Cases - Alert the Clerk's Office (telephone 212-805-0632 during business hours). If filing after business hours, alert the <u>Part 1 Judge</u> to the pending application (see their Individual Practices for contact instructions).

In Pending Cases - Alert the presiding judge (see their <u>Individual Practices</u> for contact instructions). If appearing as pro bono counsel, please also file a <u>Notice of Appearance of Pro Bono Counsel</u>.

Filing Without an Attorney

Persons without an attorney (*pro se*) challenging the legality of someone's immigration custody should review the court's guide to filing a petition for habeas corpus.
